**Zach Brown** was admitted to Clearlake hospital on Tuesday, with what was thought to be angina. His heart doctor has cleared him of any problems, but an endoscope on Thursday found that his esophagus is swollen nearly shut as it enters the stomach. They are waiting for the biopsy results to determine treatment. He remains in Rm. 455.

**Bette Green** was admitted to Clearlake Hospital on Tuesday in a lot of pain, but was doing so much better by Thursday, that they let her return home, where she continues to do well.

**Donna Robles** has been having extreme problems with her back, as a procedure she had many years ago is no longer working. She will have 2 more MRI's so the doctors can decide what the best course of actions is.

**Chris Jong** is continuing rehab at Laurel Court for rehab after her surgery and is in room 105-B.

**Wanda Whitmire** has been cleared by all of her doctors to have the surgery on her back to repair the fractured vertebrae. She is awaiting a surgery date from her surgeon.
